- Shorts (No short shorts, please)

## Dress Code

Shirts: No spaghetti straps, sleeveless, tube shirts or skintight clothing

Tank tops are allowed when appropriate (sports & activities)

Skirts: Must be just above the knee (about 3 fingers) or longer

Shorts: No "short shorts"

If the guidelines are not followed the camper will be asked to change.

## Electronics

If you choose to send your daughter with a cell phone, her room mom will keep it during the week. Anytime she may need to use the phone she may ask her room mom and work out the best time. Those who choose to not bring phones may use the cell phones of camp leaders when needed. Other electronics, which were meant to be left home will be collected and returned at the end of camp.
